## White Tank Library, Nature Center slates grand opening

The White Tank Branch Library and Nature Center officially welcomes guests during a grand opening celebration 9:30 a.m.-2 p.m. Saturday, Nov. 13. The library and nature center is located at the entrance to Maricopa County's White Tank Mountain Regional Park, 20304 W. White Tank Mountain Road, Waddell, at the western end of Olive Avenue.

During the celebration, visitors can take part in nature mini-hikes, a children's story time program, reptile feeding, discussion with a teenage author, a puppet show, hiking preparation tips, a prize wheel, and more. Young guests can also participate in several hands-on activities to acquaint themselves with the plants and animals of the Sonoran desert.

The day starts off with performances from the Shadow Ridge High School marching band and the Mountain View School choir.

Supervisor Max Wilson, Maricopa County Board of Supervisors, District 4, calls the facility a dream come true. "We are excited about opening this building to the residents of Maricopa County," he said. "There's no other county public-use building like it."


